AWARD DESCRIPTIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS

The **Building Official of the Year Award** recognizes a building official who has contributed greatly to the profession during the year. Please explain in detail the contributions the applicant has made to the profession during the past year.

The **Building Department of the Year Award** recognizes a building department which has accomplished much in four key categories: education, state affairs, community involvement, and innovation. Applicants must include a statement of qualifications under each category of up to 200 words, with attachments (press clippings, CEU's, commendations, certifications, etc.). Applicants are also asked to include an overview of their department (i.e. organizational chart, budget, mission statement, biographies of key staff, etc.). Size of a jurisdiction and its available resources shall be taken into consideration. Please submit six copies of your completed proposals.

The CTI **Educator of the Year Award** recognizes an individual who has furthered the educational development of California's building departments. Please explain in detail how the applicant has advanced and promoted education within California building departments.

Criteria for the **Hall of Fame Award** are particularly stringent. Candidates must have at least three years of continuous service in support of the code enforcement profession, during which time he/she must have given extraordinary service and made a substantial contribution to the benefit and enhancement of the profession and in excess of required duties.

The **Industry Achievement Award** recognizes the Associate Member who has been the most successful at promoting building safety. Please explain in detail how the applicant has promoted building safety.

The **Fire Official of the Year Award** recognizes a fire official who works well with building departments and contributed greatly to the profession during the year. Please explain in detail how the applicant has made efforts to work cohesively with building departments and his/her contributions to the profession.
