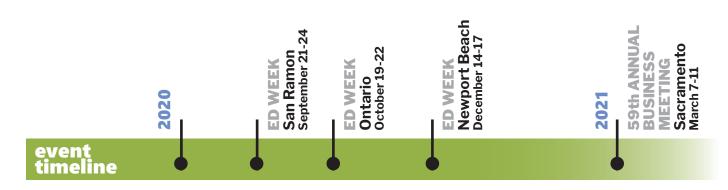
The 59th Annual Business Meeting will take place in Sacramento on March 7-11, 2021.

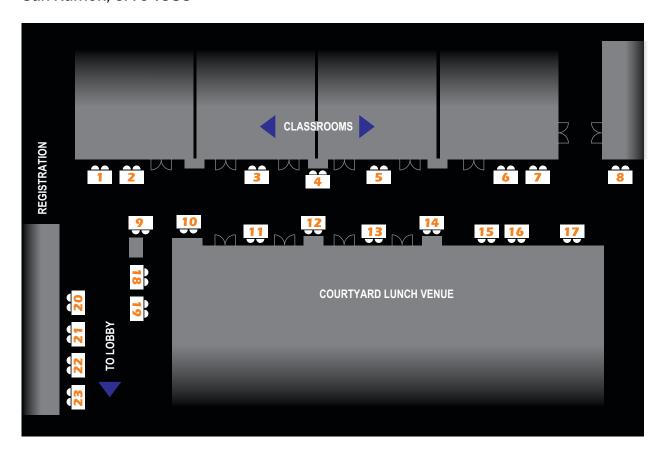
CANCELLATION POLICY

Education Week North has been held in San Ramon at this venue since 2007 with incredible success. This is the largest meeting space in the east bay area, which is what keeps CALBO returning to the venue each year. In 2019, student attendance in San Ramon surpassed 2,000 students and continues to grow each year. Given that in 2020 there will only be one Education Week in Northern California, attendance this year is expected to be record breaking. CALBO takes up all of the meeting space in this hotel and the exhibitor program is in the middle of it all – classrooms, registration and meals. Exhibitors always remark that the layout allows their booth staff the opportunity to interact with most of the attendees over the course of the week and that there is plenty of room to conduct business.

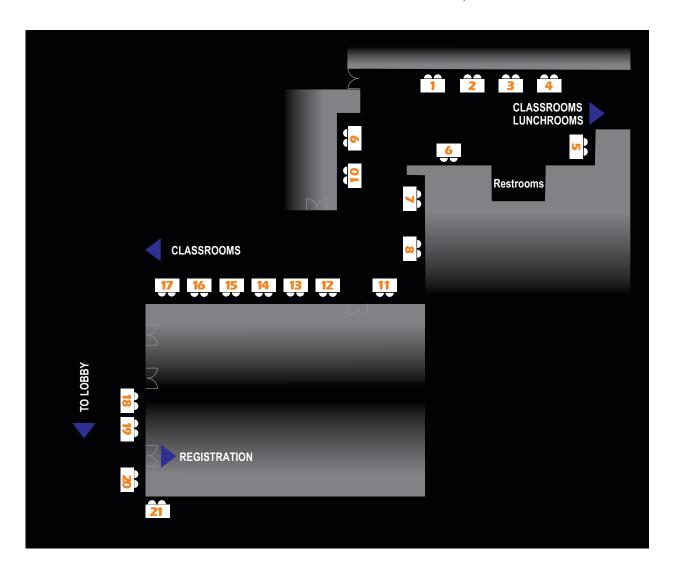

Education Week South has been held in Ontario for over 20 years. In 2008, the event was moved to its current venue and quickly became an industry favorite. Referred to affectionately as "Ontario," this is the largest event CALBO produces each year. In 2019, over 2,325 students attended this event and the number is expected to stay consistent for this year. CALBO takes up most of the meeting space at this venue, and with free parking and proximity to the airport, many students travel from the north to attend this Education Week. The hallways are busy throughout the day with consistent foot traffic in the exhibitor areas. Students and exhibitors alike have remarked that this venue always hosts a positive experience, which is why it has become a staple of CALBO training.

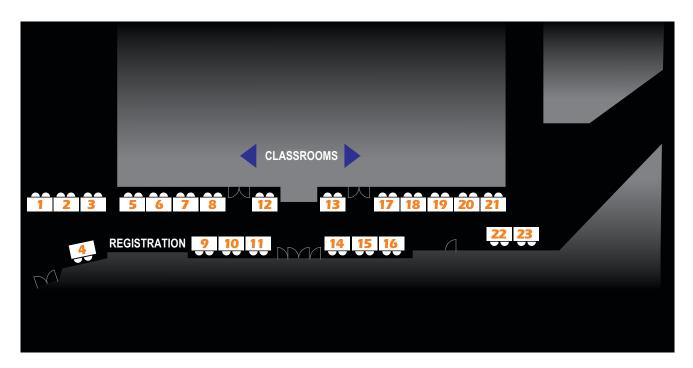

Education Week Orange County has been held for five years, each year exponentially growing. The first three years were spent in Anaheim, but then in 2019, the event was moved to this venue in Newport Beach. This Education Week was the third offering, following the North and South events, and it has done well. CALBO remains committed to this third annual Education Week and hope to stay at this venue well into the future. At this venue, exhibitors note that the hallways are tight, but there is a good flow and proximity to all students and classrooms. All exhibitors are in the main meeting area, which also includes the registration desk. In 2019, we saw over 1,200 students at this venue and we expect it to grow in 2020. This hotel is also a premium property, walking distance to many restaurants, which the exhibitor community has enjoyed in the past.

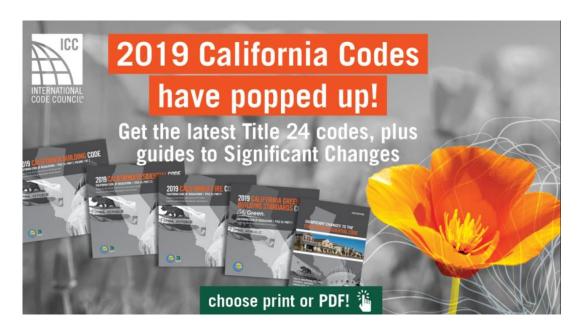
