Building Officials Leadership Academy

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Building Officials Leadership Academy (BOLA) is designed to maximize the leadership capabilities of seasoned public safety professionals, in addition to those who seek a future within California's building departments.

The Executive level coursework of the BOLA program is both demanding and rewarding. Program participants are expected to spend a great deal of time studying and collaborating with each other on the course materials. To assist and encourage completion, each participant is assigned a mentor who will provide advice and guidance, serving as an overall resource. BOLA participants are also encouraged to utilize each other's talents and strengths building upon their peer networks.

The BOLA Core Curriculum Week consists of five days of training, including five (5) courses from Monday, May 13 - Friday, May 17, 2024 in Sacramento, California. In addition, all BOLA participants are required to complete three elective courses offered at the CALBO Education Weeks. There is no time completion requirement for the electives, but all BOLA participants are required to attend the weeklong core curriculum program. There are NO make-up opportunities for missed core curriculum courses.

After a participant successfully completes all BOLA requirements, they will be recognized and honored at the CALBO Annual Business Meeting.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Program Fee: The cost of the Building Officials Leadership Academy is \$2,750, which includes all courses, materials, morning and afternoon refreshments and lunch each course day. Participants are responsible for their accommodations and travel. Payments can split into four installments: February 2, 2024, May 1, 2024, August 1, 2024, and November 1, 2024.

Creating an Administrative Foundation for a Successful Building Department 0.6 CEUs – ICC PP Course Number: 2651

This course explores the day-to-day challenges of operating a building department. Attention is given to personnel matters and developing quality employees. Instructors discuss how written policies and procedures help foster a consistent approach for your staff and good service to the public. The course reviews specific expectations of IAS and ISO in regards to how a building department should operate.

Budgeting and Finance for Building Officials 0.6 CEUs – ICC PP Course Number: 2844

This course takes an in-depth look at the budgeting process for building departments and gives a building official the tools to properly operate and function in today's economy. The course gives a hands-on approach to the line-item budget. Attendees will learn methods to justify expenditures and demonstrate how to offset expenditures with the revenues. Discussion is given to complex issues, such as revenue projections and fee studies, to help recover operating expenses of issuing permits, plan review, and building inspections.

Leadership & Advocacy Day participants will be briefed by CALBO's Advocacy Team in the morning, covering all topics and questions relative to our activities at the State Capitol. Following lunch, participants will take the short walk to the Capitol Swing Space for pre-arranged meetings with the State Legislators that represent your jurisdiction. By meeting with the Senators and Assemblymembers that represent your jurisdiction, you are showcasing the work of your local building department, while forging relationships that can benefit your community. You will also have the opportunity to represent CALBO, promoting the best interests of local building departments and our membership.

Leadership and Decision-making as a Building Official 0.6 CEUs – ICC PP Course Number: 35920

Thoughtful decision-making is one of the most important responsibilities of the Building Official. The application of administration, communication, budgeting, legislation and codes are equally significant. In this course, each BOLA participant is encouraged to think critically and envision how they can apply new tools and acquired knowledge for their current and future leadership positions. Actively engaging in a workshop format, facilitators will lead interactive exercises on applying the BOLA curriculum and personal experiences to navigate the complex technical, political, and ethical challenges ahead to thrive as a leader. This course is a hands-on approach to developing the essential skills and lessons for all future building officials.

Persuasive Communication

0.6 CEUs - ICC PP Course Number: 2652

This new course takes an in-depth look at staff report writing and presentations for building departments, preparation of ordinances and resolutions, and will give participants the tools to properly write and present to their respective administrative makeup. This course is a hands-on approach to the preparation of staff reports, insight into crafting each element to provide clear value and understanding, and how to present the item in order to ultimately win approval.
