The seminar also covers various Federal Circuit Disabled Access Case Law related to both commercial facilities and housing, and includes other topics covering the relationship of statues and regulations, the organization of the Court System, who can sue for a civil rights violation, the Fair Housing Act, Architectural Barriers Act, California's Fair Housing and Employment Act, the American with Disabilities Act, Jesse Unruh Act, the Disabled Persons Act, Construction-Related Accessibility Standards Compliance Act, and other sections of California's Civil and Health and Safety Code.
